TREE TYPE: type III/IV between Golden Delicious and Granny Smith

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: slow
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- Thinning: as difficult as Gala

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES :

- Resistant to scab (gen Vf)
- Susceptible to mildew
- Average to low susceptibility to rosy apple aphid

FRUIT:

- Skin: Shiny dark red
- Flesh: Firm and fine
- Taste : Very good balance between sugars and acidity

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: December
- CA storage: March

USES:

- Suitable for organic orchards
- One of the sweetest scab resistant varieties
- Very important to store the fruit in CA storage for post-Christmas sales
