

**ORIGIN:** cross of X4598 x X3174, France

- Breeder: DL / INRA
- Licence holder: Dalival

**PICKING DATE:** between Braeburn and Fuji, 20 days after Golden Delicious

**FRUIT SIZE:**



**BLOSSOM:** early (a few days before Gala)  
**POLLINATED BY:**

- Goldrush® Coop 39, Idared
- Malus INRA Baugène®, Malus Golden Gem

**TREE TYPE:** type III/IV between Golden Delicious and Granny Smith

**GROWTH:** weak

**PRODUCTIVITY:**

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: very good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- Thinning: needs to be controlled to avoid small fruit sizes



**SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES :**

- Resistant to scab (gen Vf)
- Low susceptibility to fireblight and mildew

**FRUIT:**

- Skin: bicoloured blushed red on a turning green background with a light russet
- Taste: very firm, very sweet with good acidity

**STORAGE:**

- Very high sugar level after storage. Do not sell just after opening the store
- Cold storage: February
- CA storage: July

**USES:**

- Strictly limited to farm shops, and organic orchards, for which the variety is particularly well suited.
- Good variety for the South of Europe

**NOTES:**
