ORIGIN: sport of Idared, USA

PICKING DATE: as Idared or Braeburn (5 to 7 days after Golden Delicious)

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM: very early (6 days before Golden Delicious)

POLLINATED BY: Alkmene, Braeburn, Arlet, Malus INRA Perpetu® Evereste or any other early flowering diploid variety

Very good pollinator for many varieties

TREE TYPE: type III / IV

GROWTH: average

PRODUCTIVITY:

- time till first cropping: rapid
- yields: excellent
- susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- thinning: easy



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE: susceptible to scab and mildew

FRUIT:

- skin : intense red on all the surface of the fruit
- flesh : firm, crisp and juicy

STORAGE:

- cold storage: May
- CA storage: July

USES:

- very good pollinator
- late sales due to its exceptional storage potential
