BLOSSOM: mid-season

POLLINATED BY:

- Braeburn, Granny Smith, Cox, Fuji, Golden Delicious, Idared or any other diploid variety with the same blossom date
- Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA Baugene®

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious)

GROWTH: average

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low

SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO

DISEASES: Susceptible to scab and canker

FRUIT:

- Skin: intensive red colour with stripes: the most striped of the coloured Galas
- Flesh: crisp and juicy
- Taste: sweet

- Cold storage: December
- CA storage: March
