

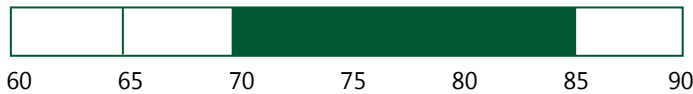
BOSKOOP VAN LAAR® BIELAAR C.O.V.

PICKING DATE: 15 days before Golden Delicious

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM:

- Triploid variety, not self fertile
- Early

POLLINATED BY: Idared, Alkmen, Arlett, Braeburn, Granny Smith

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious)

GROWTH: strong (choose M9 Pajam®1 Lancep or M9 T337)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: average
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: possible if the thinning did not work



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASE:

Low susceptibility to scab and mildew

FRUIT:

- Skin: intense red with russet, very typical of Boskoop
- Flesh: firm, average juicy
- Taste: sharp

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: February
- CA storage: March

USES:

- Suitable variety for the North of Europe and mountainous areas
- Traditional variety considered as an eating apple by the amateurs of sharp apples and as a cooking apple.
