### **PRODUCTIVITY:**

- Time till first cropping: very rapid
- Yields: excellent in the adapted locations
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing : low
- Chemical thinning: rather easy





## SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Susceptible to scab
- Average susceptibility to mildew
- Low susceptibility to canker

### **FRUIT:**

- Skin: smooth, low susceptibility to russetting, light lenticels
- Flesh: crisp and juicy
- Taste: good balance between sugars and acidity. Good taste when grown in the right locations
