GROWTH: average to good

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping : very rapid
- Yields : excellent in the adapted locations
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing : low
- Chemical thinning: rather easy



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Susceptible to scab
- Average susceptibility to mildew
- Low susceptibility to canker

FRUIT:

- Skin: smooth, low susceptibility to russetting, light lenticels
- Flesh: crisp and juicy
- Taste: good balance between sugars and acidity. Good taste when grown in the right locations

STORAGE:

- Cold storage : February
- CA storage: June / July

USES:

- Best eating qualities in mountainous areas
- This sport is especially adapted for the South European markets which prefer a yellow fruit
