BLOSSOM: mid-season (as for Golden Delicious)

POLLINATED BY:

- Braeburn, Granny Smith, Cox, Fuji, Golden Delicious, Idared or any other diploid variety with the same blossom date
- Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA® Baugene®

POLLINATOR FOR: Bramley, Cox

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious)

GROWTH: average

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low





SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES: susceptible to scab and canker

FRUIT:

- Skin: intensive red colour with stripes; excellent colour level (redder than Buckeye® Gala Simmons)
- Flesh: crisp and juicy
- Taste: sweet

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: December
- CA storage: March

USES:

- interesting sport of Gala for areas where the conditions for colour are difficult, such as Southern Europe
- lower picking costs
- better grade-outs
