BLOSSOM: 3 days before Golden Delicious

POLLINATED BY:

- Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Gala, Fuji,
- Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA Baugene®, Malus INRA Perpetu® Evereste

TREE TYPE: type II / III (semi-spur)

GROWTH: average to weak (choose a vigorous rootstock such as M9 Pajam®2 Cepiland or M9 EMLA)
