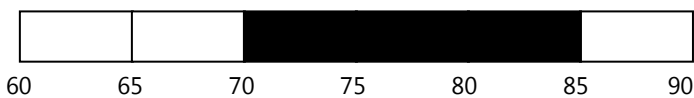


ORIGIN: cross of Gala and Maigold

FRUIT SIZE:

BLOSSOM: mid-early

POLLINATED BY:

- Golden Delicious, Braeburn, Gala, Red Idared, Elstar, Fuji
- 50% Malus INRA® Perpetu® Evereste + 50% Malus INRA® Baugene®
- 50% Malus INRA® Perpetu® Evereste + 50% Malus Golden Gem

POLLINATOR FOR: Golden Delicious, Elstar, Fuji, Jonagold

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious) with weeping branches

GROWTH: weak to average

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: very good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- Thinning: as for Golden Delicious

**SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO**

DISEASES: average susceptibility to scab and mildew

FRUIT:

- Skin: bright orange red on a golden yellow background, light russet
- Flesh: yellow, firm, crisp and juicy
- Taste: good balance between sugars and acidity and good flavours

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: March (susceptible to very low temperature – 2°C minimum)
- CA storage: June

USES:

- Suitable for farm shops
- Suitable for organic orchards
