FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM: 3 to 5 days after Golden Delicious

POLLINATED BY:

- Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Red Delicious
- Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA Baugene® c.o.v., Malus INRA Bauflor

TREE TYPE: type II, the tree has not many branches and produces on old branches

GROWTH: strong

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: slow
- Yields: very good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: possible in Southern Europe if the crop load is too heavy
- Thinning: easy



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Low susceptibility to scab
- Susceptible to canker

FRUIT:

- Shape: flat and irregular
- Skin: bronze grey and thick
- Flesh: tender, average juicy and rough texture
- Taste: sharp with sugars and flavour

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: February
- CA storage: March

USES:

- Typical variety of the French market with possible sales in Spain, Portugal and Italy
- Mainly used as a cooking apple
