PICKING DATE: Braeburn (5 to 7 days after Golden Delicious)

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM:

- As for Golden Delicious
- Triploid variety

POLLINATED BY:

- Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA® Baugene
- Granny smith, Idared or any other diploid variety with the same blossom date

POLLINATOR FOR: triploid variety, not suitable as a pollinator

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious) between Fuji and Rubinette®

GROWTH: strong

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low if the variety is thinned





SUCSEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO

DISEASES: low susceptible to scab and to canker (as for Braeburn)

FRUIT:

- Skin: similar colour as Rubinette® with a red orange blush
- Flesh: crisp and juicy
- Taste: sweet and many flavours

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: December (1°C)
- CA storage: February / March (temperature>2°C, $CO_2 < 1.5\%$, $O_2 = 1\%$)

USES:

- Suitable variety for farm shops or markets demanding very good eating varieties
- Suitable variety for the North of Europe and mountainous areas
