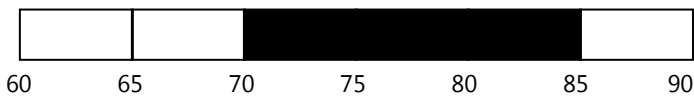


ORIGIN: sport of Redchief® Camspur

PICKING DATE: as for Golden Delicious

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM: 3 days before Golden Delicious

POLLINATED BY:

- Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Gala, Fuji,
- Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA Baugene®, Malus INRA Perpetu® Evereste

TREE TYPE: type II (spur)

GROWTH: very weak (use a vigorous rootstock and choose a high density system)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: average
- Yields: very good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: possible
- Fruit set can sometime be difficult



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- susceptible to scab and canker
- average susceptibility to mildew

FRUIT:

- Skin: very intense red colour
- Flesh: white, firm to soft
- Taste: sweet, hardly any acidity

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: February
- CA storage: June

USES: variety to be chosen for its non acidic taste and its colour or to be sold on specific markets, where it's a favourite
