PICKING DATE: 10 to 15 days before Golden Delicious (similar to Boskoop)

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM: triploid variety / Very late (5 days after Golden Delicious)

POLLINATED BY:

INRA Belchard® Chantecler, Malus INRA® Bauflor

POLLINATOR FOR: Triploid / Not suitable as a pollinator

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious)

GROWTH: strong (use rootstocks such as M9 Pajam® 1Lancep, M9 NAKB or M9 T337)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: average
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: average
- Thinning: easy



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Very resistant to scab
- Possible susceptibility to canker

FRUIT:

- Skin: orange red with russet
- Flesh: crisp to tender
- Taste: acidic taste and very good flavour

STORAGE:

- Cold storage: January
- CA storage: February

USES:

- Organic orchards
- Do not grow under warm climate (the fruit can burn and the flesh can become floury)
