

ORIGIN: cross of Elstar x Cripps Pink, France

- Breeder: Dalival
- Licence holder: Dalival

PICKING DATE: between Golden Delicious and Braeburn (5-7 days before Braeburn)

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM: mid-season (as for Golden Delicious), not many flowers

POLLINATOR: Braeburn, Granny Smith, Cox, Fuji, Golden Delicious, Idared or any other diploid variety with the same blossom date

TREE TYPE: similar to Elstar, very bushy tree, production on brindles

GROWTH: weak to average (choose a strong rootstock such as M9 Pajam®2 Cepiland or M9 EMLA)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- time till first cropping: rapid
- yields: average yields
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: low
- susceptibility to alternate bearing
- thinning: very susceptible to chemical thinning



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

low susceptibility to scab

FRUIT:

- very attractive pink red bicoloured apple with a distinctive flat shape
- firm and crisp, very fine and light wick explode in the mouth; good flavour

STORAGE:

- March in cold store
- June in CA storage

USES: this variety is particularly suitable for farm shops due to both its good eating qualities and distinctive shape
