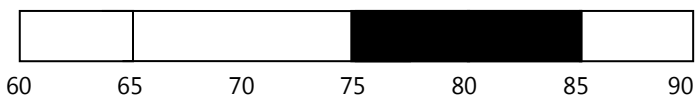


ORIGIN: cross of Gala x scab resistant selection, ACW (Switzerland) and INRA (France)

PICKING DATE: 2 to 3 days before Golden Delicious

FRUIT SIZE:



BLOSSOM: 3 days before Golden Delicious

POLLINATOR: Topaz, Ariane, Dalinbel, Goldrush® Coop 38, Story® Inored, Malus Perpetu® Evereste, Malus Golden Gem, Malus Baugène

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious), open tree. Short pruning particularly suits the variety

GROWTH: average

PRODUCTIVITY :

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- yields: average to good yields
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: not very susceptible
- thinning: as Golden Delicious



SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

resistant to the common scab strains (gene Vf / Rvi6)

FRUIT:

- bicoloured, blushed purple red on a yellow background
- very firm, juicy; sweet and very aromatic

STORAGE:

- February in cold store
- May / June in CA storage

USES: this sweet, very aromatic scab resistant variety with very good storage potential is perfectly suited for organic farm shops. However, it requires several picks to optimize colouring
