BLOSSOM: mid-season (as for Golden Delicious)

POLLINATED BY: Braeburn, Granny Smith, Golden Delicious, Idared, Ariane, Dalinbel, Goldrush® Coop 38, Crimson Crisp® Coop 39, Story® Inored, Dalinette, Malus Golden Gem, Malus Baugene

TREE TYPE: type III (Golden Delicious)

VIGOUR: medium to low (prefer rootstock type M9 Pajam® 2 Cepiland or M9 EMLA at least)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Good yields
- Low susceptibility to alternate bearing
- Easy thinning





SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES:

- Resistant to the common scab strains (gen Vf / Rvi6)
- Tolerant to fireblight
- Low susceptibility to meldew

FRUIT / FLESH:

- Bicoloured with 80% minimum dark red
- Yellow flesh, sweet, very juicy and with very original flavours of peach and lychee

STORAGE:

- End of December in cold store
- February in CA storage

USES:

- This variety has a truly original taste and is easy to produce
- Suitable variety for organic orchards
