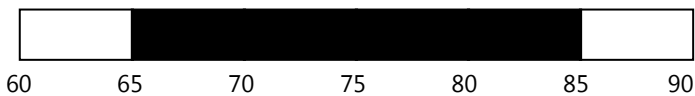


**ORIGIN:** cross made by INRA / NOVADI (France)  
- Breeder: INRA / NOVADI  
- Licence holder: NOVADI

**PICKING DATE:** 10/15 days after Granny Smith (1 month after Golden Delicious)

### FRUIT SIZE :



**BLOSSOM:** Granny Smith

### POLLINATED BY:

- Ariane, Goldrush® Coop38, Golden Delicious, Gala, Red Delicious, Granny Smith, Idared
- Malus Perpetu® Evereste, Malus Golden Gem, Malus INRA Baugène®

**TREE TYPE:** type III (Golden Delicious), production on terminal buds

**GROWTH:** average (use rootstocks such as M9 Pajam® 2 Cepiland or M9 EMLA minimum)

### PRODUCTIVITY:

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good to very good
- Low susceptibility to alternate bearing
- Thinning: compulsory



### SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO DISEASES :

- Resistance to the common strains of scab (Vf / Rvi 6 gene)
- Low to average susceptible to mildew
- Beware of possible secondary flowering

### FRUIT :

- Skin: blushed and very attractive intensive red
- Taste: very sweet (13 to 14° Brix) with very low acidity (6 g / L).
- Flesh: very dense and firm (7.5 kg / cm<sup>2</sup>)

### STORAGE:

outstanding storage potential: 8 months in normal storage (at 3°C), with a very good shelf-life

### USES:

- For the South European climates
- Outstanding storage potential when stored at 3°C.
- Very attractive and sweet variety
- Suitable variety for organic orchards
