ORIGIN: mutant of Jonagold (France)

A Jonagold clone with a very high colour level, producing coloured fruit, even in hot summers, and maximising grade-outs.

THE TREE

TYPE OF TREE: type III (Golden Delicious)

PRODUCTIVITY:

- excellent productivity
- time until first cropping: average
- susceptibility to biannual bearing: possible after heavy crop loads
- easy to thin



VIGOUR: strong

BLOSSOM DATE: average (1 to 2 jours before Golden Delicious)

POLLINATORS: Idared, Gala, Elstar or any other diploid variety with the same blossom date

S-ALLELES : triploid variety

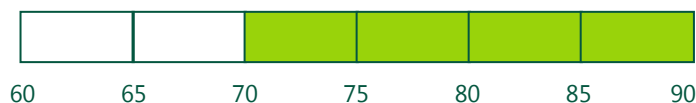
THE FRUIT

PICKING DATE: as Jonagold

FRUIT / FLESH:

- dark red fruit, 100% blushed. The most coloured of the blushed Jonagold clones.
- eating qualities: good if the crop load is not too strong

STORAGE POTENTIAL:

- February in normal cold store
- June in CA storage
